Ken Belanus Wood Turning Demonstration – February 27, 2012



Ken Belanus was educated as a Mechanical engineer at Iowa State in Ames. He worked in the oil industry for 15 years, earning his Masters degree at the University of Texas in Arlington. He taught engineering technology at the University of Pittsburgh, PA, and at Oklahoma State University for 22 years. Along the way he renovated four houses and custom-built another, which sparked his interest in building furniture. He bought a lathe to make music stands. He discovered that his artistic side just blossomed naturally as he learned to use the lathe. Ken's dad was a great spindle turner, and Ken saw woodworking as a child, but he was not allowed near the process because of childhood allergies. Ken never had a lesson from his dad, but is self-taught. The resurgence of interest in woodturning and the availability of books on the subject fostered his natural learning style. He turns lidded boxes, chess sets, tops, kitchen items, and replacement spindles, but only a few bowls. Much of his wood is locally harvested and seasoned. He first "pre-turns" the wood, then acclimates it to his home environment so it stays stable in yours.

He will bring a small lathe about the size of a sewing machine to demonstrate recent tooling that can be used to create eccentric and phased decorative cuts, spirals, and textures on the surface of turnings. 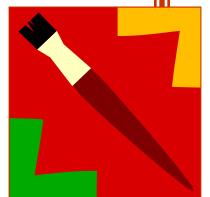

General Rules & Instructions

- Only paid members of Stillwater Art Guild may enter, but you may join at the same time you drop off your art for the show.
- Only **three (3)** works per member *regardless* of medium.
- Original artwork only. FAMILY FRIENDLY, please. NO NUDES. *Original means the painting must be authentic, one-of-a-kind work of art which may NOT be copied from any published or on-line photo (such as a magazine, book, art publication), or art work of another person. Work must be the entering artist's original concept, design, style, and fabrication.*

All exhibiting artists **must** sign the artist entry form; failure to do so shall immediately disqualify the artist from participating. Decisions of the Show Committee and Judge are **final**.

Media categories: Acrylic, Graphics, Jewelry, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastels, Photography: B&W/Color, Watercolor, Digital Art and Sculpture/Pottery/3-D.

Minimum size of artwork must be 8"x10" *excluding* frame. **Maximum size** is 24"x36" *excluding* frame. Frames must be wired for hanging with **screw eyes 1/3 of the way down the sides of the frame.** All artwork must be signed.

Divisions for all media categories: Children: under 13 ---- Young People: 13-18 years of age, Adult: over 18 years of age, and further categorized as: Advanced ---- Intermediate ---- Beginner

2012 Spring Show Judge—Rick McClure

Spring Show – Additional Rules:

- All work must have been completed within the last **two (2)** years and not previously entered in any annual Stillwater Art Guild **judged** show. Photographs are considered completed when they are framed.
- **NO** class work or work done under teacher supervision. **NO** photocopies.
- **AWARDS:** Best of Show (1 only!) For all categories and divisions: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place, and Honorable Mention ribbons. *(To be awarded at Judge's discretion – all decisions are FINAL!)* Show attendees will vote for a Peoples' Choice (Certificate).

Remember, each artist is allowed only 3 entries total, regardless of medium.

ORIGINAL: entirely your own concept, design, style, and hand work; not copied from any published photo, print, magazine, art book, or work of another artist. "Borrowing" as such will be considered plagiarism and the artist will be disqualified.

I agree to be responsible for my work as listed below, which is displayed at the Stillwater Community Center, and will not hold the Stillwater Art Guild or the Stillwater Community Center liable for damage or loss.
